Small Projects, Big Impact: The Levi Yitzchak Children's Library is a privately funded library for Jewish children's books that is open to the public. Each area is themed: The entrance hallway features lit panels showing the six days of creation, a Mitzvah Train provides reading nooks, a Torah scroll bulletin board exhibits children's work, and a puppet theater evokes the Jubilee Synagogue in Prague.
